



OUTSIDE SPACES TRANSFORMED BY DESIGN



Sue Rew's lifelong fascination with rocks and pebbles finally found artistic expression when she discovered the art of pebble mosaics. As a result Sue made a lifestyle decision to leave her career in biotechnology and follow her heart to set up her business "**Sue Rew Mosaics**".

Initially her own Cotswold garden was the blank canvas for her creativity. The pebbles and old handmade bricks dug up there, together with a desire to act responsibly and recycle local materials inspired her to create designs sympathetic with their environment.

Sue's mentor is the world renowned pebble mosaic artist Maggy Howarth, who has acknowledged Sue as an "emerging new talent" "in her latest book "The Complete Pebble Mosaic Handbook (revised and expanded)".



Sue creates mosaics in sections within her workshop, like a giant jigsaw, so she can undertake long distance commissions without the extra expenses associated with working on site. For her clients that means there is minimum on-site inconvenience and far less delays due to our unpredictable British weather.

Success came quickly for Sue in 2007 when the show garden "Casino Royale" at the Malvern Spring Show featuring her 007 mosaic won a RHS silver gilt award. Since then Sue's mosaics have featured in other award winning show gardens and she would love to demonstrate her talents in a garden at The Royal Chelsea Flower show.

Amongst Sue's commissions are a dragonfly for a country hotel, an abstract wave inspired design for a luxurious Cornish seaside retreat and a Japanese themed mosaic for a Cotswold Country House.

As a guideline a 60cm/ 2 foot square design starts at approximately £400.

Sue also holds one day workshops at her Cotswold studio.
